

An Impressive Victorian Villa Style House typical of the area, fronts two buildings architectural designed as modern care facilities. The Villa Homes offer traditional comforts, impressively restored, retaining many of its character features and creating areas that are light and spacious; invoking opportunity for themed meaningful activity.

Set high above the famous coastal town of Paignton in Devon our home enjoys commanding sea views, established and well maintained garden, terrace and grounds. Paignton originates from a Celtic settlement, now forming part of the English Riviera that includes Torquay, Paignton and Brixham. Primley Court has years of experience in the care and support of people with a mental health diagnosis. This can include Schizophrenia and Bi-polar where we provide a service that ensures people progress through the recovery model to being able to have fulfilment in a more independent life.

Dementia Care

We as a partnership continue to evolve our services in line with meeting the needs of people with a diagnosis of dementia, we ensure a person centred approach that includes everyone who is able to assist our staff in understanding the person, so we work as a team to allow the person to enjoy their new home.

We are proud to follow the accredited programme of Dementia Care Matters that provides a platform for us to look at the complexities of our resident's life, in a person centred way. Working in a culture that observes, has outcomes and detailed levels of intervention using this positive dementia methodology.

Primley Court proudly provides the local authority with specialist short term dementia assessment services; providing the local community with an invaluable step up or step down pathway of care enabling stabilisation of acute events and giving time for appropriate longer term care packages to be arranged by our Social Service colleagues; thus preventing unnecessary hospital or long term care admission.

End of Life Care

Our specialist facility at Primley View offers the best quality nursing care to people requiring support at all stages of their lives. This is especially important when it comes to our palliative care service for people who are not expected to recover.

Our nurse led team work with highly skilled local, multi- disciplinary healthcare professionals to provide 24 hour specialist support to individuals with end stage illnesses.

Our environment offers the space, tranquillity and carers trained to provide this crucial support needed by individuals, their family and friends in these difficult times. The highest quality of care and attention is given to those nearing the end of life and this includes pain management, physical, psychological and spiritual care, as well as emotional support.



Primley Court

Primley Court offers 20 bedrooms within its Victorian House which retains many of its character features; in addition 31 Bedrooms are available each with their own en-suite in our purpose built extension.

Assisted Bathrooms and or wet room facilities are available on all floors. There are two lifts that are able to accommodate wheelchairs and quite areas around the home giving residents an opportunity to have their own space when they so choose.

The View is a traditional 28 bedroom care centre that offers a comfortable homely and friendly service in a Victorian Villa & modern purpose built area set high on the hill side of Primley Park enjoying commanding sea views across Paignton and Torbay. The home caters for all catering needs and choices and is skilled in working with speech & language therapists where special dietary requirements are indicated; the home offers all nursing equipment and care facilities for higher nursing needs including the services of trained staff for undertaking base line observations, venepuncture, and other laboratory screening, oxygen therapy management; pain management and clinical interventions under the direction of the managing GP or Palliative Care Team.

How to find Primley Court

BY CAR leave the M5 or the A30, follow the signs for A380 to Torbay and continue for about 13 Miles, take the right hand lane passing over the Penn Inn flyover at Newton Abbot and continue on the bypass towards Torquay and Paignton.

At the first set of lights on the dual carriage way keep to the right following signs towards Paignton and Brixham on the A380.

On reaching the Totnes Road Junction & Traffic Lights turn left on to the A3022 travelling about 1 mile towards Paignton town; turn left on to Primley Park Road; the home can be found a short distance up the hill.

BY TRAIN head for Paignton Rail Station, situated opposite the Paignton Bus Station where a number 22 or 100 bus can be taken to the Totnes Road Stop adjacent to Primley Park Road.



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
